Schooling permitted until 7:45 am and at scheduled breaks. Hard Hats Required. Limited to 10 horses at a time.

CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Over the series 10 (Champion) and 6 (Reserve) points will be awarded and accrue for Hi-Bid challenge trophies and special awards to be presented at final show. CCHSA point system incorporated.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All fence heights are approximate.
2. Informal attire is acceptable but hard hats and safe footwear are required.
3. Martingales are not permitted in flat and under saddle classes. Except Beginner Rider.
4. All decisions of the Judge are final.
5. Management reserves the right to combine, cancel or divide classes as entries warrant or to vary the order of classes to expedite the show.
6. Hi Bid Farm and the management cannot be held responsible for any accident, injury or loss which may occur to any exhibitor, owner, groom, rider or attendant, or horse or equipment at the show.
7. NO LOOSE DOGS will be tolerated on the grounds at any time.
8. In the interest of safety, please use trash cans. Thank you.
9. A child's riding age is the age as of December 1st. Birthday on December 1st rides at that age.

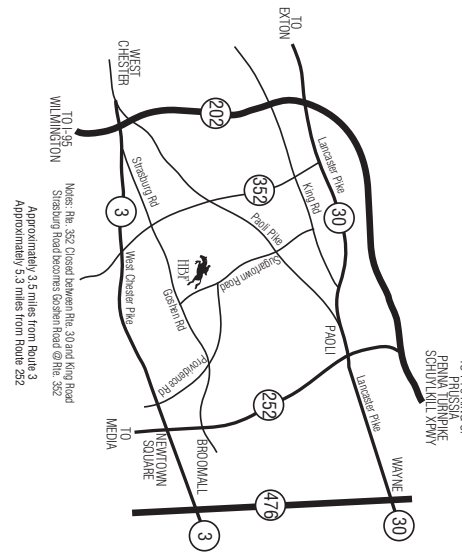

SHORTEST STIRRUP

Open to children eight (8) years old and under. May cross enter Pleasure Pony and Short Stirrup only. Judged on hands, seat, general appearance and control of mount (horse or pony). No CCHSA bonus points for CH & Res.

SHORT STIRRUP

Open to children ten (10) and under. Riders may enter other divisions except at an USEF recognized horse show. Open to horses or ponies, judged the same as shortest stirrup.

JUNIOR BEGINNER RIDER EQUITATION

Open to junior riders in their 1st or 2nd year of showing. Riders may cross-enter Low Childrens or Pleasure. Martingales permitted in under saddle classes as well as over fences. Fences 2'.

NOVICE EQUITATION

Open to junior and adult riders who have not won 6 blue ribbons in equitation classes over fences prior to this year. Beginner Equitation ribbons not to count. Will be split if entries warrant. Fences: 2' ponies, 2'-3" horses.

LONG STIRRUP PLEASURE

Open to adult riders 30 years of age and over who are Novice Riders. May enter: Pleasure & Low Adult Hunter. Fences 2'.

Open to all junior riders. To count towards CCHSA year end awards as a combined 13 & under / 14-17 equitation division. Will split if entries warrant. Fences 2'-3" ponies, 2'-6" horses.

LOW CHILDREN'S PONY HUNTER

Open to junior riders. May NOT cross enter regular hunter classes. Fences 18" - 2' small & medium, 2'-3" large.

Open to junior riders. May NOT cross enter regular hunter classes. Fences 2'-6".

CCHSA PONY/HORSE MEDAL

42. Open to Junior Riders. May be divided if entry warrants- Fences 2', 2'-3", 2'-6" ponies, 2'-9" - 3' horses.

ADULT MEDAL

43. Open to Adult Amateur Riders. Fences 2'-9" - 3' horses.

ADULT EQUITATION

Open to amateur persons 18 year or older, riding horses or ponies. Fences 2'-6" - 2'-9" ponies, 2'-9" - 3' horses. Horsemanship only to count.

Open to horses ridden by amateur persons 18 years or older. To be judged on manners and suitability of mount to rider. Fences 2'-6".

BABY GREEN HUNTER

Open to all horses and ponies seven (7) years old and under in their 1st or 2nd year of showing. Horses are allowed to show in this division for two years as long as they meet the age requirement. Exempt from showing are previous year's high score champions and reserve champions. May trot corners. Adults may ride ponies. Fences 2' small & medium ponies, 2'-3" large ponies, 2'-6" horses.
